#### RIGHTLY DIVIDING THE WORD OF TRUTH

## II Timothy 2:15-19

#### Intro:

- A. Words are vehicles for carrying ideas.
  - 1. They carry man's ideas.
  - They carry God's ideas.
- B. Paul warns Timothy of those who wrongly use words. Vs 14
  - 1. They used words in such a sloppy way that their hearers were not helped.
  - 2. Their inaccurate use of God's word resulted in a confused and demoralized congregation. Vs 14

## I. The Preacher Is A Workman. Vs 15

- A. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God,..."
  - 1. "Study" = σπουδαζω = "to give diligence", "Earnestly".
  - 2. "Approved" = δόκιμος = "proven by being tested".
  - 3. "Shew" =  $\pi\alpha\rho\iota\sigma\tau\eta\mu\iota$  = "to cause to stand near".
  - 4. "Earnestly endeavor to present yourself..."
- B. "...a workman that needeth not to be ashamed,..."
  - 1. "Workman" =  $\dot{\epsilon}\rho\gamma\dot{\alpha}$ T $\eta\varsigma$  = "worker" There is no particular occupation named. The context is mute.
  - 2. "Ashamed" = ἀνεπαίσχυντον = "having no cause for shame".
  - 3. "...who doesn't have to be ashamed"
- C. "...rightly dividing the word of truth."
  - 1. "Rightly divide" =  $0\rho\theta$ 0T0 $\mu\epsilon\omega$  = "to cut along a straight line" This figure of speech could be referring to plowing a straight line, cutting stone straight, or cutting material in a straight line such as a tentmaker.
  - 2. "Declaring the word of truth without distortion" CON

# II. The Result Of Wrongly Dividing God's Word.

- A. Vs 16 "But shun profane and vain babblings:..."
  - 1. "Shun" = Περιιστημι = "to shift around", "avoid".
  - 2. "Profane" = βέβηλος = "unhallowed", "common".
  - 3. "Vain babblings" =  $K \in VO Φωνια$  = "empty sound".
- B. "...for they will increase unto more ungodliness."
  - 1. "Increase" =  $\pi \rho O K O \pi T \omega$  = "to set before", "advance".
  - 2. "Ungodliness" =  $\alpha \sigma \in \beta \in \iota \alpha$  = "without God".
  - 3. "Avoid all that profane jargon for it leads people still further into irreligion".
- C. Vs 17 "And their word will eat as doth a canker:..."
  - 1. "Eat" =  $\nu 0 \mu \eta$  = "grazing", "feeding", "pasture".
  - 2. "Canker" =  $\gamma\alpha\gamma\gamma\rho\alpha\iota\nu\alpha$  = "gangrene", "cancer", "or spreading ulcer". This adequately describes the insidious spread of any false teaching.
- D. "...of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus;"
  - 1. "...are men of that stamp"
  - 2. Cancer is serious, Paul meant to have Timothy know exactly what he meant."

### III. A Specific Example Of Wrong Division.

- A. Vs 18 "Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already;..."
  - 1. "Erred" =  $\alpha \sigma To \chi \in \omega$  = "to miss the mark", "to go astray".
  - "Who have swerved from the truth".
  - 3. "They preach that the resurrection has come about already".
- B. "...and overthrow the faith of some."
  - 1. "Overthrow" =  $\alpha \nu \alpha \tau \rho \pi \omega$  = "to turn up or over".
  - 2. "and they are overturning the faith"

# IV. The Truth Cannot Be Destroyed.

- A. Vs 19 "Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal..."
  - 1. "Foundation" =  $\theta \in \mu \in \lambda \log = \text{"fundamental"}$ .
  - 2. "Sure" =  $\sigma T \in \rho \in \hat{O}S$  = "solid", "firm", "immoveable".
  - 3. "Seal" =  $\sigma \phi \rho \alpha \gamma i \varsigma$  = "a marking".
  - 4. "Yet God's solid foundation stands unmoved and this is the inscription on it".
- B. "...The Lord knoweth them that are his...."
  - 1. "The Lord knows His own" NEB
  - 2. "...those who are really His" TAY
- C. "...And, let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity."
  - 1. "Depart" =  $\alpha \phi \iota \sigma \tau \eta \mu \iota$  = "to leave", "let every one stand off from", "a definite break".
  - 2. "Let every one that uses the Lord's name break from and stand away from all wickedness."
