#### Introduction:

- A. Another angel. vi
  - "and after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven having great power."
    - a. power = eksousia delegated authority.
  - 2. "and the earth was lightened with his glory."
    - a. lightened = photizo to light up, illuminate.
- B. The announcement of the angel. v2
  - "And he cried mightily with a strong voice, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen."
    - a. cried = Krazo to scream.
    - b. fallen = pipto to fall, This is repeated as though it is a funeral dirge.
  - 2. "and is become the habitation of devils and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird."
    - a. habitation =- katoiketerion = down-dwelling. A permanent dwelling, a settling down, for demons.
    - b. hold = phulake a watching = prison.
    - c. foul = akathartos impure, unclean, unatoned.
    - d. cage = phulake prison.
    - e. unclean = akathartos -= unatoned.
    - f. hateful = stugetos to be hated, abominated.
- I. THE THREE REASONS FOR HER DOWNFALL. V3
  - A. "For all nations have drunk of the winepress of her fornication."
    - All of the nations have been intoxicated by the success and glory of one-worldism.
  - B. "the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her." v3

- i. The rulers of the world court one-worldism.
- 2. They are lured to the bed of false religion.
- C. "the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies."
  - merchants = emporos one who goes on ship-board as a passenger, a wholesale dealer.
  - waxed rich = plouteo to be wealthy.
  - abundance = dunamis = power.
  - 4. delicacies = strenos rudeness, insolence, pride; hence, revel, riot, luxury, (as a gangster or drug dealer lives in opulence.)

#### II. GOD'S PLEA FOR SEPARATION. V4.5

- A. There is "another" voice from heaven.
  - "come out of her my people."
  - 2. "that ye be not partakers of her sins."
  - 3. "that ye receive not of her plaques."
- B. Judgment is ready to fall.
  - "for her sins have reached unto heaven."
    - a. reached = kollao to stick to, to join to, Her sins have been joined or piled together until the over growing mass rose sky-high.
    - b. Remember the Tower of Babel?
  - 2. "and God hath remembered her iniquities."
    - a. remembered = mnemoneuo remember.
    - b. iniquities = poneria evil nature, sad state or condition, the wicked act of the wicked delighting in evil.

#### III. GOD'S STANDARD OF JUDGMENT FOR BABYLON.

- A. God has set His laws and warned all. v6-8
  - 1. Psalm 137:7-9. [593 B.C.]
  - 2. Rev. 13:9,10.

- B. Kind for kind.
  - "Reward her even as she rewarded you."
  - 2. reward = apodidomi to give in full.
- C. Double for each wicked work.
  - 1. "and double unto her double according to her works."
  - "in the cup which she hath filled, fill to her double." Jesus cup in Gethsemane.
- D. Torment and sorrow for self-glory and reveling.
  - "How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her."
  - 2. glorified = doksakso honor, praise.
  - 3. deliciously = streniao to live hard, revel. This is exemplified by our, high-energy lifestyle.
  - 4. torment = basanismos = torture.
  - 5. sorrow = penthos mourning, lamenting. For every honor give dishonor, for every hour of reveling give two of torture.
- E. Babylon's arrogance. Three things:
  - 1. "for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen."
  - "and am no widow." Never in any wise shall be a widow.
  - 3. "and shall see no sorrow."

#### IV. BABYLON'S DAY OF DEATH. V8

- A. "Therefore shall her plagues come in one day."
  - 1. plagues = plege a stroke, a blow.
  - 2. day = hemera = sunrise to sunset.
  - 3. death = thanatos.
  - 4. mourning = pentheo to bewail, lament.
  - 5. famine = limos failure, want, as of food.
- B. "and she shall utterly be burned with fire."
  - 1. burn utterly = katakaio to burn down.

Any way we may look at Babylon, she is evil. She must be burned to the ground.

### V. HOW CAN THIS BE?

- A. "for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her."
  - 1. strong = megas = great.
  - judgeth = Krino to divide, to separate, to make final judgment.
- B. "come out from among her."
  - 1. "my people."
  - 2. Do not participate in her evil or her judgment.
